The new building of Düsseldorf's higher regional court is mainly the scene of legal cases relating to state security and terrorism. The heart of the building is formed by two soundproof courtrooms, which have cabins for simultaneous interpreters and screens for video transmissions. In the large courtroom, there is room for 145 people, 15 persons undergoing trial, 60 lawyers and 30 security officers; as in the smaller trial hearing room, accused persons and observers are separated from each other by a three-meter high glass wall.
