After 55 years, the chamber of the Bavarian parliament in the Maximilianeum was renovated completely according to the plans of Staab Architekten. In the chamber, which is now bright and modern thanks to the new daylight ceiling, there are 164 places for members of parliament with six rows of desks. The members of the government sit on the government bench. The functions and media systems match the needs of a modern working parliament.
