A former industrial building in the Via Stendhal from Mussolini's time serves as Diesel's headquarters. Riva Calzoni, a mechanical engineering company whose turbines convert the energy of the Niagara Falls into electricity, used to be accommodated here. The building is to be found in the Zona Tortona, which has recently established itself as the fashion district of Milan. In addition to administration with the areas marketing and public relations, the Diesel flagship store is also located in the new rooms. The renovated and rebuilt walls were kept transparent and as pure as possible by the architects. Natural working conditions and colours as well as the well-being of the employees were the main goals during planning.
